#### **NEW SHINGLES CAMPAIGN 2023**

You may have seen in the press recently that there is a new campaign for shingles vaccination. Almost a million more people (900,000) will become eligible for a shingles vaccination from September, the NHS announced back in the summer.

Anyone who is severely immunosuppressed and over 50 will be able to get two doses of the Shingrix vaccine – currently the vaccine is only available to those over 70. From 1 September 2023, those turning 65 and 70 will also be able to get the vaccine after their birthday, in addition to those already aged 70-80. Shingles can occur at any age, but the risk and severity of shingles and its complications increase with age and is higher in individuals who have a severely weakened immune system.

Patients will be contacted by us here at the practice if they are eligible, but we had to concentrate on our flu and covid campaign leading up to winter, so please wait to be contacted later in the year or into January.

### STAFF TRAINING AND SURGERY CLOSURES WEDNESDAY AFTERNOONS IN 2024 – DATES TO FOLLOW

The nature of working within a GP Practice means that our team members both clinical and administrative, work to tight time slots, the majority of which is spent with patients. Whilst this is a key element of our work, it means that there is no time for whole team staff training or hold vital meetings to support learning. To support us in being able to have time for these aspects of our work we have achieved approval from the Integrated Care Board that we will operate an emergency only service for patients on a designated Wednesday afternoon each month from 1.30pm until 6.30pm to allow these meetings to take place. The dispensary and surgery will be closed except for access to emergency care via an initial telephone assessment service.

We will publish our dates on our website and in the foyer so that all patients are aware of our opening times. We appreciate your support with these closures for vital training and to help us improve procedures and processes within our teams.
